KAMAN AEROSPACE NAMES ROBERT J. KANASKIE DIVISION PRESIDENT OF AEROSTRUCTURES-JACKSONVILLE

BLOOMFIELD, Conn. (July 11, 2006) -- Kaman Aerospace Corp. today announced the appointment of Robert J. Kanaskie as president of the company's Aerostructures Division operation in Jacksonville, Florida.

Kanaskie will be responsible for the Aerostructures-Jacksonville facility, which manufactures aircraft structures and components for commercial and military aircraft, including applications on Boeing commercial airliners, the C-17 transport, and the Sikorsky BLACK HAWK helicopter.
