Bloomfield, Conn., Sept. 12, 2007 — Kaman Corporation's Helicopters Segment will play a key role in future Sikorsky BLACK HAWK and SEAHAWK® helicopter production under a three-year Memorandum of Agreement recently executed between Sikorsky Aircraft and Kaman. Sikorsky is a subsidiary of United Technologies Corp. (NYSE:UTX).

Kaman will join a significant number of cabin, cockpit, tail cone and landing gear assemblies for UH-60L, MH-60S, and UH-60M BLACK HAWK and SEAHAWK helicopters.
